As the day's temperature rises, cool breezes drift in from the Delta, keeping the nights cool which is ideal for the development of complexity in finished wines. Soils: Well-drained rich mineral soils, sandy to clay loam. Varietals: 80% Zinfandel; 10% Petite Sirah, 4% Syrah, 4% Teroldego, 1% Sangiovese, 1% others. **Age of Vines:** 90 year-old estate vineyard imparts intensity, while the 25 year-old estate vineyard produces bright fruit. Sustainably Farmed: 100%; Lodi Rules **Sorting**: Vineyard sorting Winemaking: Grapes are fermented 12 days at 85F. Some lots pressed at dryness, others up to 4 weeks after crush to maximize varietal expression. Aging: 85% of wine was aged with French and American oak for 6-8 months to enhance fruit with spice.
